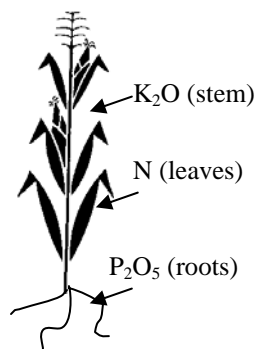

Corn Trivia

A kernel of corn is mostly starch (~60%), but also has protein (~20%), oil (~4%) and water (~16%). An ear of corn averages 800 kernels. Corn is usually planted in April and harvested in September. Corn is used in soup, chewing gum, cornmeal, toothpaste, baby food, ink, paper and fuel as well as many other products like soda and fireworks.
