A license to handle milk shall be required for any individual or entity who receives, bargains, brokers, or issues payments for or purchases milk from Kentucky permitted producers or their agents. The license to handle milk is issued annually with the year beginning on July 1 and expiring on June 30. A completed application with appropriate fee shall be submitted to the Division of Regulatory Services prior to receiving milk from or issuing payments to permitted Kentucky producers or their agents. The fee is determined by the volume or weight of milk handled during the previous year.

Please make remittance payable to the University of Kentucky and return to the above address. It is unlawful for any handler of milk to receive milk from or issue payments to permitted Kentucky producers or their agents without obtaining a license to handle.
